Physical Requirements/Environmental Conditions: 1) Requires prolonged sitting or standing. 2) Requires physical exertion to manually move, lift, carry, pull, or push heavy objects or materials. 3) Must be able to lift 30 pounds on a repeated basis throughout an 8 hour shift. 4) Requires stooping, kneeling, crawling, bending, turning, and reaching. 5) Requires climbing and balancing. 6) Must work indoors and outdoors year-round. 7) Must work in noisy and crowded environments. 8) Must work in and around dust, fumes, and odors.
